We are a global supply chain management company. We buy, sell and move physical food, packaging and energy products, business tobusiness, on behalf of our clients. We also stock, carry and repackage physical product and provide warehousing solutions, logistical support and vendor-managed inventory. CZ's physical trading business is transaction-rich and asset light, as we do not own any production assets.

From specialists at their desks to farmers working remotely, we provide in-depth market analysis at the touch of a button through our newly developed app Czapp. We are expanding this platform further to include a new positions function which will allow users to see their active trades and to communicate in multiple languages.

Since 2019 we have been in renewable energy, deepening our expertise through new employee appointments and broadening our offering, which now includes biomass derived from sugar and food production, electricity generated from solar and steam, and ethanol. This investment delivered our first renewable energy trades in 2021. Most of this activity is in Brazil at present, with ambitions to expand into Asia and Africa in this area.

Our renowned sustainability programme, VIVE, focuses on continuous improvement and creating value throughout the supply chain. This allows our clients to deliver sustainable improvements, demonstrate traceability and differentiate products – creating commercial advantage. In addition to this, we currently have 306 kWh of VIVE-verified electricity available to power end-to-end, sustainable supply chains.

We are a fast-moving, dynamic company – we make decisions quickly and implement those decisions with speed. Our employees are given responsibility early and are given opportunity to advance as quickly as they can.

Our Analysis team is key to being able to support our clients run their businesses and make informed decisions. From using machine learning to efficiently processing commodity market data to analyse the latest market trends, you'll develop your technical understanding as well as build communication skills while working alongside leading market analysts.

At CZ we trade financial instruments which allow our clients to protect themselves against adverse market movements. On the team you'll have the ability to execute and structure trades across a variety of commodities and markets, including sugar, grains, dairy, packaging, oils, transport, energy, forex and more.

On the Operations desk you'll get involved in planning shipments with buyers, placing freight bookings with shipping lines and coordinating call forwards with suppliers. You will be kept on your toes as you leverage problem solving skills to address unexpected supply chain challenges to ensure our buyers receive their goods on time and within budget.
